General Information

What have we done?

- We have carried out a COVID-19 risk assessment. (Copies are available in church and on our Website: www.middletonparishchurch.org.uk)
- We have cleaning, hand cleansing and hygiene procedures in place, in line with government guidance.
- We have taken all reasonable steps to help everyone maintain a 2m distance between different users of our church.
- Where possible there will be 72 hours between church uses and service preparation. Where not possible, cleaning will be carried out.

What we expect you to do?

- Refrain from entering if you are feeling unwell or have experienced any COVID-19 symptoms in the past seven days or are self-isolating.
- Take responsibility for your own safety and that of your household and other people by maintaining social distancing and observing hygiene measures.
- Regarding who can attend church please ensure that you are practicing current government guidelines for any categories or groups you are in, particularly if you are in an 'at-risk' group. Anyone who is shielding is advised NOT to attend church at this time.
- Face coverings are required to be worn.

A Walk through a Service

Booking system:

- To book for the forthcoming Sunday please phone the Parish Administrator/ Warden – 0161 6534526 on the Monday before.
- If you have booked and change your mind for any reason, you must let us know as soon as possible no later than <u>Thursday</u>. Do not pass your booking on to anyone else.
- If you are too late to book for a place on any Sunday, please ring again on Tuesday for the following Sunday, and you will be given priority. You cannot book for more than one Sunday at a time.

Welcome:

- Please arrive no more than 15 minutes before service starts and enter via the North Porch, observing social distancing.
- On entry, following hand hygiene, each adult should complete a Trace and Test form.
- You will be given clear guidance on where you can sit, and shown to your place. Please remain in this seat.
- A system is in operation, please follow directions.

During the Service:

- Initially, there will be one short, simple service at 10:30am, beginning on the 9th August 2020, for everyone. Children must stay with their adults at all times. We will review what we are able to provide over the coming weeks.
- We are currently not permitted to sing. However, we may use music for reflection at key points in the service.
- A collection plate will be available at the back of church at entry and exit points.
- Initially services will <u>not</u> be Eucharistic <u>and</u> there will be no sharing of the peace.

End of a Service:

- Please leave church promptly as directed through the South Door.
- If you wish to have a conversation with others, we encourage you do this outside, maintaining social distancing.

Other:

- Toilets will not be available except in an emergency.
- If you have any concerns, please speak to a steward.
